

Rib Point Pro SightLine



For anyone looking to tighten up their gun mount and eye alignment, Rib Point Pro's SightLine is a clever little tool designed for safe, dry-fire practice at home. Slip the sleeve over your shotgun rib and you can instantly check that your eye sits squarely over the rib. From there, it's simply a case of repeating the motion until your mount becomes second nature.

Sized to fit common rib widths (6, 8 or 10 mm - other sizes are available), the sleeve provides a clear visual reference for consistent head and gun position. In case you're wondering, this isn't a clip-on sight - it's held in place by small magnets and is purely designed to practise and improve your mount and dry-fire drills.

Once clipped into position, the rib and bead should sit level and central. Any tilt, offset or high-eye position shows up instantly. It's designed to build muscle memory (with an unloaded gun) at home, without recoil or distractions - it's all about repetition, muscle memory

and fine-tuning your gun fit. And it works!

Founded by shooting coach Stephen Spencer and engineer Mike Hulme, this UK micro-brand sells direct online and through a small number of retailers, including North Wales Shooting School. It's a snug fit once clipped into place - but make sure you measure your rib width correctly, as a loose fit would rather defeat the point.

FIRST IMPRESSIONS

I must admit, I'm impressed. Before delivery, I had it filed under "might be handy", but it's now been promoted to "bloody useful." I have a Blaser F16 which was, I thought, a perfect fit straight out of the box.

With my usual relaxed mount, it still is - but when simulating live shooting, like a flurry on a walked-up day or the added pressure on a peg, I found myself pulling the gun tighter or gripping a little firmer in the heat of the moment. That's when I noticed the bead drifting south and my sight picture going off - which likely explains a few puzzling misses in the past from what is, ordinarily, a very reliable game gun.

A quick installation of the accompanying Stock Adjuster kit (more on that next month), and the problem was solved. A problem I didn't even know I had, neatly sorted thanks to a small piece of 3D-printed plastic. Genius!

VERDICT

As a sub-£30 training aid, the SightLine is an easy win. It's smart, safe and genuinely useful - whether you're looking to build confidence, retrain your mount or refine gun fit. Highly recommended and a seriously handy add-on for any committed shotgun shooter.
